Sub: Grant of conditional permission to the Swami Raghwendracharya Tridandi Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Gaya, Bihar for UG (BAMS) course with 40 seats under Section 13C/A of the IMCC Act, 1970 for the academic session 2013-14 - reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Department's order No. 17011/09/2012-EP (IM-1) dated 12.07.2012 related to admission matter for the year 2012-13 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the 2013-14 session.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 19-20.06.2013 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Department.

3. The recommendations and visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012 published on 19.07.2012 in the Gazette of India with the subsequent amendment published on 23.04.2013 and as per approval of the Hon'ble HFM for the UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic year 2013-14, based on the notified MSR, vide Department's letters No.R.11011/10/2013-EP (IM-1) dated 11.06.2013, dated 26.06.2013 and further letter dated 19.08.2013 and it is found that the College is fulfilling the notified and approved criteria as follows:-

- (i) Teachers: 90% eligible teachers, minimum 11 Higher Faculty (Professor+Reader) in the college and at least one eligible teacher in each of 14 Departments;
- (ii) Beds in hospital: Minimum 60 beds in hospital of Colleges;
- (iii) Minimum 36320 patients in OPD during the year 2012;
- (iv) 40% bed occupancy in IPD during the year 2012; and
- (v) Equipment and instruments: Minimum 50% of required equipment as specified under the schedule VII of MSR.

4. It has, therefore, been decided to grant conditional permission to the Swami Raghwendracharya Tridandi Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Gaya, Bihar to take admissions with 40 seats in (UG) BAMS course for the academic session 2013-14 under section 13C/A of the IMCC Act, 1970 subject to the condition that the college will fulfil the following requirements by 31st December, 2013 which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2014-15 onwards (a copy of Assessment Sheet of CCIM is also enclosed):

- (i) The Minimum Standards Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Sub-Regulation (3) of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012" with the subsequent amendment published on 23.04.2013 by 31st December 2013, to get conditional permission for the session 2014-15.
- (ii) All the Minimum Standards Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012" with the subsequent amendment published on 23.04.2013 by 31st December 2013, to get permission for a period not exceeding five years.
- (iii) All the requirements under the relevant Indian Medicine Central Council Regulations should be fulfilled in particular for teaching, non-teaching including laboratory staff and hospital staff.

5. Further, the college is directed that the post of EMO, Radiologist, Panchkarma assistant and Attendant in clinical laboratory may be filled positively within two months time as they are essential for medical education/running of hospital.

6. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Department of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report in this matter to the Department of AYUSH for considering the permission matter for the session 2014-15.
