
Sub: Grant of permission for a period not exceeding 05 years to the Swamy Raghavendracharya Tridandi Ayurved Mahavidyalaya & Chikitsalaya, Gaya, Bihar for 40 seats in BAMS course under Section 13C/A of the IMCC Act, 1970 from the academic session 2014-15 to the academic sessions 2018-19 – reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Department's order No.R.17011/09/2013-EP (IM-1) dated 01.10.2013 related to admission matter for the year 2013-14 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the 2014-15 session.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 20-21.01.2014 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Department. On examining the same, it was observed that independent computer and printer facility in the office of Dean, Medical Superintendent and each of 14 teaching Departments and functional College Website are not available for granting permission for a period not exceeding five years as per the notified MSR Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 30.07.2014 to present the case.

3. The observation of hearing Committee based on submission made by the college during hearing, recommendations and visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approval of the Hon'ble HFM on criteria for grant of conditional permission to ASU colleges for taking



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admissions in the UG/PG course(s) for the academic session 2014-15 vide Department's letter No.R.11011/10/2013-EP (IM-1) dated 17.06.2014 (available at Department's website <indianmedicine.nic.in>) and it is found that the College is fulfilling the notified and approved criteria as follows:-

- (i) Teachers: For UG course: 100% eligible teachers, 15 Higher Faculties (Professor + Reader) in 14 Departments in the college, 1 P/R + 1L in each of 13 Dept. & 1P+1R+1L in Kayachikitsa and 1L of Sanskrit and 09 part time teachers up to 60 UG seats;
- (ii) Beds in hospital: Minimum 60 beds in hospital of college for UG course in case of up to 60 intake capacity;
- (iii) Minimum 120 patients per day in OPD during the year 2013 for up to 60 UG seats;
- (iv) 40% bed occupancy for UG College in IPD during the year 2013;
- (v) Equipment and instruments: Minimum 90% of required equipment and instruments as specified under the schedule VII of MSR;
- (vi) Fulfillment of provisions including staff requirement under relevant Education Regulations; and
- (vii) Other infrastructure and staff required as per the MSR Regulations of 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013, in addition to above requirements for grant of permission for a period not exceeding five years.

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to *grant permission* under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 *for a period not exceeding five years* to the **Swamy Raghavendracharya Tridandi Ayurved Mahavidyalaya & Chikitsalaya, Gaya, Bihar** with *40 seats in UG (BAMS) course from the academic session 2014-15 to the academic session 2018-19*, during which the college shall not be inspected, except for random checks on receipt of any complaint, or otherwise as deemed necessary either by the Central Government or by the Central Council of Indian Medicine as specified in Sub- Regulation (2) of Regulation 3 of the Regulations namely the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012" read with amendment Regulations of 2013.


5. The college shall maintain all the Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations, 2013, provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder *in toto* during the period of permission (i.e. up to 2018-19). As per the provisions of Sub-Regulation (2) of Regulation 3 of the MSR Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013, the Central Council shall visit the college *suo moto* three months before the expiry of

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permission to verify the requisite infrastructure and facilities required under above mentioned Regulations by means of an inspection and shall submit a report to the Department of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2019-20.

6. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.


